Ruffled Peddler Shawl

Wool Peddler's Shawl "Ruffled" variation

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Work as written for Wool Peddler's Shawl from *Folk Shawls* up to direction to "Begin Lace" (You will have just finished a RS row)

Break yarn and change to the contrast color if desired for the next row.

Knit one(WS) row.

On the next (RS) row you will be increasing by adding yarn overs between every 2 sts to dramatically increase the st count and create the ease for the "ruffle".

Work the Ruffle Increase row as follows: K1, yo, *k2,yo; repeat from * to the last st of the row, K1 (Approximately 347 sts on the needle).

Knit one row.

Skip the lace instructions and go directly to the Bottom border directions. Repeat rows 1 and 2 of the bottom border a total of 28 times (56 rows)

Block the shawl following the blocking directions in *Folk Shawls* spreading ruffle out to make it softer and more drapey or leaving it in for a more ruffled appearance.
